**School Streets Day of Action Friday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2022**

The Clean Cities Campaign is a European initiative to encourage cities to transition to zero-emission mobility by 2030. The impact on the environment and on public health from polluting vehicles is particularly prevalent in the cities. In an area of high pollution rates, we need to consider the safety of our children and ourselves by reducing the problem. School streets are roads in front of schools closed to traffic, leading to safer roads and cleaner air. They also encourage families to walk, cycle or use public transport to get to school.

On Friday 6<sup>th</sup> May, there will be a School Street Day of Action. Our Green Team will be leading the school to support this day of action. The Green Team works hard to ensure we all look after our planet. They have three core areas which they are focusing on this year, including Healthy Living. At the end of the school day the Green Team will be stationed on Trent Road to urge adults to cut pollution and to park responsibly, so that we are all kept safe. The Parents' Association are also holding an ice lolly sale as you take time to consider some of the issues being raised.
