



From the Headteachers

Please see below a message from our Chair of the Governors about two vacancies on our Governing Board. You should also have received a more detailed letter today in an email giving more information about being a governor, the requirements of the post and a copy of the qualifications and disqualifications sheet. This summarises the circumstances under which someone cannot serve as governor.

PARENT GOVERNOR VACANCIES

Corpus Christi's Governing Board oversees the school and supports the head-teachers to make sure that pupils get the most out of their school experience. I'm the Chair of Governors and started on the Governing Board as a Parent Governor eight years ago before becoming a Foundation Governor.

Being a governor is an interesting insight into how schools work. You oversee the school's overall strategy and ensure that the budget is spent wisely.

It's not a time-consuming role: there are termly board meetings, and each governor also takes on a couple of other roles, such as becoming the link governor for English or PE (which would mean coming into school once a year to talk to the staff member responsible and writing a short report) or joining the Resources committee.

There are two spaces for new Parent Governors available and I'm holding a zoom meeting next week to explain more about what governors do and to answer any questions anyone has about the role. All are welcome.

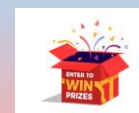
Cakes & Home Produce
