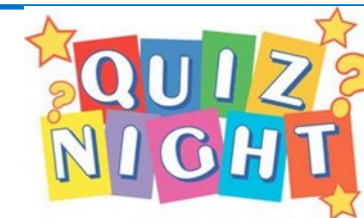
#### Dinner Money—Spring Term 2018
