From the Headteachers

English at Corpus Christi

As you may be aware one of our School Improvement Plan (SIP) priorities is Reading, Phonics and Spelling. As part of our commitment to developing this area, we are pleased to tell you that we have recently invested in a brand-new spelling scheme: 'Spelling Shed' which focuses on the etymology, morphology and orthography of words. It encourages children to look at the parts that make up a word (morphology) and their origins and meaning (etymology). Spellings will have a phonetic focus and look at the patterns within our English spelling system (orthography). We are moving away from 'look, cover, write, check' as we encourage children to learn the parts/syllables of the words rather than trying to memorise whole words. The new scheme includes online access so children can play words games and practise their spellings at home. Login details for children in Year 1 - Year 6 will be sent home within the next two weeks. (You do not need to purchase the app.)

Last year, we also invested in the 'Big Cat Phonics for Letters & Sounds' scheme which has been designed so our younger children can apply their phonic knowledge to decoding, blending and reading words at their level. These books include helpful tips and guides to support parents/carers when reading with children. They also provide children with books that give visibility and representation to everyone in society by including characters from a range of ethnic and social backgrounds, and by telling stories about people with differing abilities and that challenge gender stereotypes. This is important because it boosts self-esteem and engagement for children from all backgrounds and promotes acceptance and kinship.
