Ofsted

On Wednesday and Thursday of this week we were visited by Ofsted as part of the school's inspection process. The school was notified on Tuesday morning, the day before the visit, to make us aware of the arrival of the inspectors at 8am the next morning. We would like to thank all parents who completed the Parent View survey which is an important part of the inspection process. Parent View had 199 responses which the lead inspector said was exceptional. We would like to thank all parents who contacted us with their well wishes and kind words of support. We should be able to share the outcome with you by early June.

Smartphone

Despite the best efforts of teachers, schools often have to deal with negative situations involving the use of smartphones and social media outside of school. This statement is true in both secondary and primary schools and is something we must deal with too here at Corpus Christi. This is primarily around the use of WhatsApp groups but can also occur in relation to other social media and gaming consoles. Attached to this email is information detailing the work of Smartphone Free Childhood which is a grassroots movement of parents who believe childhood's too short to be spent on a smartphone. Before the end of term, we will conduct a SurveyMonkey to find out about your children's use and ownership of smart phones in the weeks leading up to Karl Hopwood's visit in July. He is an independent online safety expert who is a member of the UK Council for Child Internet Safety.
