From the Headteachers

All Saints Mass

On Tuesday of this week children from Year 2 to Year 6 attended Corpus Christi Church for All Saint's Day with the parish on this holy day of obligation. This was the first time that the children had attended Mass since the beginning of the pandemic. Class 14 prepared the readings and bidding prayers and the school choir prepared hymns. It was wonderful to see the children attend Church again and celebrate the Eucharist with the parish community. This week we also welcomed Fr Matthew into school to work with Year 6 during an RE lesson on ordination. This begins a series of visits to the school to support religion lessons. Father Matthew has also joined the school's Governing Board this academic year and we are grateful as always for the support that he gives to the school community.

AGM

On Monday 28th November at 5.30pm we have our Annual General Meeting in the Main School Hall. The meeting will formally approve the school accounts for the academic year 21/22 and the Chair of Governors will also provide information relating to the performance of the school. The meeting will have school governors and trustees from the diocese in attendance. All parents are also invited to this meeting.

Gymrun

Physical health underpins the physical competence, confidence and motivation needed to engage positively in physical activities, leading to sustained involvement in PE and sports. We trialled Gymrun with Year 5 children last year and are rolling it out to all juniors this half term. Gymrun consists of exercises to push children physically, cognitively and personally. The exercises support children's core movements in fitness, gymnastics and athletics. Children are assessed at the end of a term and can work their way up within a badge system. These badges need to be sewn on the child's PE top. If a new top is purchased, the badge should be unpicked and sewn on to the new top to demonstrate progression.

There are 8 badges to achieve but your child may begin to achieve a badge higher up within the system. Year 5 really enjoyed Gymrun last year and I am sure your children will look forward to achieving their badges.
