## **Attendance is Everyone's Business**

Following the recent government changes regarding school attendance and expectations on schools and parents, we attach to this newsletter information received from Lambeth Education Welfare Services about these changes and parental responsibility. It states that 'as a parent of a school aged child who is on a school roll it is your responsibility to ensure that your child is in school during the time and dates the school states it is open from. Regarding holidays, the Education Law states that it is not a parent's right to take a child out of school during term time to go on holiday. Families must seek permission from the school for any absence. For any authorised holiday, there must be extenuating circumstances therefore they cannot authorise a holiday because it is cheaper outside of term time.'

#### Wellbeing

This week we had a PWWP (Parent Wellbeing Working Party) meeting and a RULER presentation also for parents about the emotional intelligence programme that we teach in school.

We have also followed the requests in the summer parent survey for Wellbeing suggestion post-boxes. One is mounted on the brick pillar in the Junior playground and one is mounted next to the school office. Parents and children are welcome to make requests - there is paper and a pen with the boxes.
