## Relationships Education and Health Education

In the academic year 2020/21 Relationships Education and Health Education became statutory in all primary schools in England. This subject will build on the non-statutory lessons we have previously taught in RSE. RSE is an abbreviation of Relationships and Sex Education. At Corpus Christi School, we have always had an RSE policy in place and have taught this subject across all year groups for many years. This has included teaching about physical changes during puberty in Year 5 and human reproduction in Year 6.

We have been researching various programmes that are available to support our teaching and have decided to adopt Life to the Full by Ten Ten Resources. Ten Ten is an awardwinning Catholic educational organisation that is wellrespected and very experienced in this field of work. This scheme is recommended by the Education Commission for the Catholic Archdiocese of Southwark.
