A New Term

Happy New Year, we hope you had a restful Christmas holiday and have enjoyed spending some extended time with your children. All the children have settled in well to the new school term and we thank you for ensuring the children have return to school looking smart as always. Today we said goodbye to Ms Morrison and Mrs Giles as they go on maternity leave, and we wish them and their families well. We look forward to sharing some photos of the new arrivals in the coming weeks.

Covid Update

Since Wednesday 22 December, the self-isolation period for individuals who test positive for COVID-19 December has been reduced to 7 days in most circumstances, unless you cannot test for any reason. Individuals may now take LFD tests on day 6 and day 7 of their self-isolation period. Those who receive two negative test results are no longer required to complete 10 full days of self-isolation. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 6 of the self-isolation period and tests must be taken 24 hours apart. This also applies to children, with LFD testing at parental or guardian discretion.

If both these test results are negative, and you do not have a high temperature, you may end your self-isolation after the second negative test result and return to your education setting from day 7 or 8 depending on the time of testing. Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests will need to complete the full 10-day period of self-isolation.

The government has also announced that from 11th January in England, people who receive positive LFD test results for COVID-19 will be required to self-isolate immediately and will not be required to take a confirmatory PCR test (if they have no symptoms.) Anyone who receives a positive LFD test result should report their result on GOV.UK

After reporting a positive LFD test result, they will be contacted by NHS Test and Trace so that their contacts can be traced and must continue to self-isolate. Anyone with symptoms should stay at home and self-isolate and still take a PCR test.

School Events

The Christmas Fair that was due to take place this weekend has once again been postponed and will now be held later this Spring Term. Class assemblies and other school events will take place online and be filmed so they can be viewed by families on the google sites. We will review this again on $26^{\rm th}$ January and will invite parents back to school for events as soon as we possibly can.

Primary School Transfer

If your child was born between 01/09/2017 and 31/08/2019 your child should be starting primary school in September 2022.

Nursery parents need to apply online through your home borough for your child's primary school place.

This is known as a common application form. Please ensure you complete this by **midnight Saturday**January 2022. If you apply after this date the likelihood of gaining a place at your preferred school may be significantly reduced therefore, apply online and apply on time.
