Online Safety Meeting Monday 8th July

There will be a meeting for parents on Online safety at St Martins in the Fields and we strongly encourage you to attend, irrespective of the age of your child. Online behaviour and access to mobile phones is a continuing challenge we face with children and young people.

We are delighted to have a guest speaker, Karl Hopwood, who has a wealth of experience in this field. Karl is an independent e-safety expert, he is a member of UKCCIS (UK Council for Child Internet Safety) and sits on the advisory board for the UK Safer Internet Centre and the education advisory board for CEOP. As an exprimary headteacher, he continues to work closely with children, young people, parents, and teachers to develop safer online behaviours and the promotion of digital literacy.

The meeting for parents will take place at 9.15am, the hall will be open from 9am, to give time for parents to arrive from the main site. The meeting will approximately 50 minutes and then Year 5 and 6 will be attending a workshop afterwards.

A survey will be going out to parents soon to gauge parent's opinions on the use of mobile phones for children and young people.
