Book Week

Today we had our Book Week Assembly where children from Nursery to Year 6 had a chance to dress up as a character from a book. This is a very special day in the Corpus Christi calendar, and we would like to thank you for the great lengths you go to make costumes and props and helping the day become such a success. We would also like to thank Mrs Jenson for all her hard work in organising events this week. Next Wednesday Year 4 & 5 children will meet author Jane Elson in school, and she will share with them her books Moon Dog and Swimming to the Moon.

British Science Week

Next week we will be celebrating British Science Week. The theme for this is 'Time' and children across the school will be exploring how time is key to so many discoveries in science, technology, engineering and maths. From evolution to the Earth's movements, lifecycles and the invention of the clock. Each class will be by taking part in mini investigations in class and tuning into online sessions with STEM speakers.

<u>Measles</u>

Measles is in the news again and Lambeth have seen a mixed picture of cases, including children and young adults who are unvaccinated against the disease. Regrettably, some cases have attended schools during their infectious period, which not only puts pupils and students at risk but also our valued teachers and staff.

The MMR vaccine provides the best protection against measles, requiring two doses for full protection. While the first dose is typically given at 12 months and the second from 18 months as per the UK vaccination schedule, it's never too late to catch up on missed doses. Parents are advised to contact their GP to ensure that your child is up to date with vaccinations.

Lambeth Public Health is organising two sessions of MMR vaccination clinics at the **Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG**. Children and adults are welcome to attend.
