School Uniform

The children's uniform is a distinctive feature of Corpus Christi School and members of the public regularly comment on how nice the children's uniform is, as well as their exceptional behaviour. We really appreciate all your efforts in ensuring the children's appearance is of a consistently high standard. As a reminder we would like to clarify some of the issues with uniform that we regularly address; Children in Reception to Year 6 must wear a plain navy blue coats, no logos allowed. If your child wears earrings they must be plain silver or gold studs. Girls with long hair should have it tied back and boys hair must be above the ears and not have any dramatic changes in length i.e. it should blend from shorter to longer without a line of demarcation. Hair extensions are not permitted. Thank you for your continued support and cooperation.
