Achieve 100 Revision Books

Dear parents,

Merry Christmas! We are writing to explain in detail the procedure the children should follow when completing their lovely Christmas presents: the wonderful Achieve 100 SATs revision books.

We have explained the following to the children today:

- When revising, spend a few minutes looking through the corresponding page in the 'Study' book, ideally making notes and thinking about questions which may be asked.
- Then turn to the 'Practice' book to complete that page as best you can.
- After you have completed the number of pages set by your teacher, please go through the pages with an adult (or older sibling), marking and discussing the answers and any misconceptions together.
- The adult/older sibling should then sign the bottom of each page.

In addition:

- SPAGs Achieve 100 books are due in on Mondays.
- English Achieve 100 books are due in on Wednesdays.
- Maths Achieve 100 books are due in on Fridays.
- We encourage the children to bring in their books **every day**, as there may be time for them to study independently and complete pages at certain times.
- After checking through their work, each pupil will be awarded a grade for effort and set the next amount of pages to complete by the next date.

Thank you for all your extra support during this term – the additional revision at this time is invaluable in the lead up to their assessments. If you have any queries, or there is an area/misconception that your child finds particularly tricky whilst completing the books, please do not hesitate to get in touch and let us know.
