

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NSPCC - TEAM

The NSPCC suggests parents and carers are an essential part of the T.E.A.M that helps keep children safe online:

T = Talk about staying safe online

E = Explore their online world together

A = Agree rules about what is ok and what's not

M = Manage your family's settings and controls

Simplified version of Instagram Terms and Conditions

Officially you own any original pictures and videos you post, but we are allowed to use them, and we can let others use them as well, anywhere around the world. Other people might pay us to use them and we will not pay you for that.

we may keep, use and share your personal information with companies connected with Instagram. This information includes your name, email address, school, where you live, pictures, phone number, your likes and dislikes, where you go, who your friends are, how often you use Instagram, and any other personal information we find such as your birthday or who you are chatting with, including in private messages (DMs).

We might send you adverts connected to your interests which we are monitoring. You cannot stop us doing this and it will not always be obvious that it is an advert.

We can also delete posts and other content randomly, without telling you, for any reason. If we do this, we will not be responsible for paying out any money and you won't have any right to complain.













YouTube: Restricted Mode

- Be a good role model: Use media the way you would your children to use.





Understand the importance

- of privacy settings.
- Good quality passwords and the need to change them regularly.
- Treating others online well
- Correcting inaccurate information
- Deactivate accounts no longer used











Identity theft

- Keep personal information private
- Use strong passwords, keep them private and change them regularly
- Don't give out personal information for rewards.
- Take care when signing up to services, (third parties use your information).
- Check privacy settings.
- Learn about digital rights

Online bullying

- Look for changes in behaviour
- Talk to your child about what is/ has happened.
- Be clear they are not alone who they can approach
- Save a copy of the message as evidence
- Block sender
- Report to school


