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Covid arrangements Lower KS2

- Morning drop off and afternoon collection arrangements remain the same: 8:45am – 9am and 3pm-3:15pm. Year Three's collection point is at the black gate on Trent Road and Year Four's collection point is at the car park gate on Lambert Road.
- If you have arranged for another parent or family member to collect your child, please inform the office by telephone and class teacher by email.
- If a last-minute change is made to end-of day collection please ring the school office and they will inform the class teacher.
- All children must have their own named stationery. This should include an ink pen, coloured pencils, pencil and ruler.



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PE: Every Wednesday

- The Lower Juniors will have an outdoor PE lesson every Wednesday with our school PE specialist teacher.
- Please ensure your child comes to school wearing their PE kit. The school PE kit consist of the white school t-shirt, navy shorts and trainers.
- Children can also wear the school PE jumper and school tracksuit bottoms over their shorts on their PE day. We encourage this during the colder months.
- Children will not need to bring their school uniform into school with them as they must remain in their PE kit all day.
- Children do not need to wear their school hat to school on this day.



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Homework

- To allow the children time to adjust to being back in school, homework and spellings will begin being set after the October half term.
- Homework and spellings will be set online and more information will be given out about this when the time arrives.
- Reading books will be sent home on a weekly basis so please ensure your child has their reading book every day. We also encourage reading of non-school books to encourage an understanding of a variety of texts.
