This is a History based topic.

The topic will be developed by looking at the changes in the United Kingdom from the end of the Ice Age up to the Roman Invasion. We will concentrate on the lives of ordinary people and how humans went from hunter gatherers to settled farmers. We will look at the ancient landmarks in the U.K. in particular Stonehenge and Skara Brae. We will examine the way humans utilised natural resources and in particular the importance of flint as a tool.
