**Gymrun**

The children from Year 3 to Year 6 had their assessments for Gymrun before Christmas and badges are now available to purchase for £2.00. This money can be given to your child's class teacher and they will receive a badge at the appropriate level which can be sewn onto their PE shirts or sweatshirts. Through this all child's fitness achievements are celebrated. The Gymrun Program is a leading approach to develop fitness and physical literacy. Gymrun empowers children to become fitter, engages staff, evidences fitness impact and embeds a wider fitness culture in our school. Through Gymrun as well as building fitness understanding, children also develop a physical and resilience. Gymrun was created with every child in mind, particularly those who are less active and less physically competent. Gymrun also supports all five key indicators for the Sports Premium Funding, and there are six areas of the NC PE program of study.
