Holocaust Memorial Day

Holocaust Memorial Day marks the 80th anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau. On 27th January 1945, Soviet soldiers opened the gates of Auschwitz concentration camp liberating more than 7,000 prisoners. The liberation will be marked with services worldwide. The BBC will be marking the day on 27th with a wide range of programmes across TV, radio and online. Lambeth's commemoration takes place this Sunday and Corpus Christi School choir will be in attendance singing three songs. The theme of Holocaust Memorial Day this year is 'For a Better Future'.
