During this week we have had 43 incidences of children arriving late for school. We ask for a real concretive effort by parents to get their children to school on time and aim for 08:40am when the gates open. The children then go straight into class and begin their morning work and are ready for registration at 08:50am. Previously parents would have had to wait in the playground for their child's teacher.

We are all affected by traffic, bus delays and road closures, so we ask that families who are frequently late arriving make every effort to be on time. Lateness not only impacts the classroom routines and morning assemblies but also the office staff who have to escort children to their classes. The school gates close at 08:50am and any child arriving after this time will be marked late. Good punctuality is an important life skill.
