OCEAN WITH DAVID ATTENBOROUGH

Corpus Christi science ambassadors are attending the Future Generations premiere of OCEAN WITH DAVID ATTENBOROUGH which will take place next Tuesday 6th May at the Royal Festival Hall. We are so excited to have been chosen for this event and look forward to hearing all about it from the children when they return.

The children will get to walk a red carpet, attend an exhibition displaying some of Sir David Attenborough's work, watch a screening of his new film about the Ocean and watch a Q&A with Sir David. The film takes viewers on a breath-taking journey showing there is nowhere more vital for our survival, more full of life, wonder, or surprise, than the ocean. In the film the celebrated broadcaster and filmmaker reveals how his lifetime has coincided with the great age of ocean discovery.

Stunning, immersive cinematography will showcase the wonder of life under the seas and expose the realities and challenges facing our ocean as never-before-seen, from destructive fishing techniques to mass coral reef bleaching. Yet the story is one of optimism, with David Attenborough pointing to inspirational stories from around the world to deliver his greatest message: the ocean can recover to a glory beyond anything anyone alive has ever seen.

Free School Meals - New Rules

Free School Meal eligibility will be changing from 1st April 2025

Pupils who are eligible for free school meals with eligibility between 1st April 2018 and 31st March 2025 will be eligible until the end of their school phase, year 6, your status will then need to be rechecked.

Pupils with eligibility from 1st April 2025, we are now required to carry out termly checks. Parents will need to inform schools of changes in circumstances.
