



FROM THE CO-HEADTEACHERS

We trust all had an enjoyable summer break and were pleased to see your children return to school on Tuesday. Thanking you in advance for your continued support and cooperation, it is much appreciated.

Attendance

During this morning assembly we were delighted that 176 children from Years 1 -6 received their summer term attendance badge for being in school all of last term. Many children also achieved 100% for the academic year 2024- 2025. Unfortunately, medical appointments are counted as an absence, so please consider how appointment times could be taken outside school time or before/after registration (8.50 am and 1.30 pm). School gates are open from 8.40 am, so please aim for your child to be at school soon after this time, so they are ready for registration at 8.50 am and present for the teacher's explanation of the early morning work. They will be marked late after 8.50 am and will miss their teacher's explanation of the work. Good punctuality is an important life skill.

Parking on School Roads

We would like to remind parents to park away from the school roads and walk to the school gates with your children in the morning and again at the end of the day. The roads around the school are busy and unfortunately an incident occurred yesterday afternoon on Trent Road which could have lead to a young child being injured. If you have parked on one of the school roads please do not carry out dangerous manoeuvres like three point turns and mounting the pavement, the pavements are very busy at the start and end of the day. If we have similar incidents reported to us we will have no alternative but to ask Lambeth Parking Service to attend and if necessary issue parking tickets.
