Next week is anti-bullying week. The children will be learning about the theme for this year, 'Choose respect,' a link to the song linked to this year's campaign is <u>here</u> - please do share it with your children.

We would also ask that on Tuesday 12th November, your children come to school wearing odd socks to celebrate what makes us all unique. We will be teaching the children what the definition of bullying is: Sustained, Targeted, Or Persistent (STOP) unkind behaviour towards one person or a group of people. The role of the bystander will also be taught to the children, as well as the importance of speaking up and telling an adult if we feel we are being bullied or spot it happening to anyone else.
