- **Pupils are eager to learn because the curriculum is well designed, aspirational and interesting**
- **The curriculum in early years is sequenced so that children build knowledge very well over time**
- **The school sees reading as being central to all pupils' learning**
- **The school has high ambitions for all pupils, including those with special educational needs and/or disabilities**
- **Behaviour at the school is exemplary**
- **While there is a buzz of busy learning, pupils understand when it is appropriate to work quietly and when it is time for discussion**
