ROYAL ACADEMY OF MUSIC

The Royal Academy of Music is delighted to be working with Corpus Christi on its first ever Community First Strings Experience (CFSE) programme.

Transporting our well-established early years strings programme for 4-7 year olds to the primary based in Brixton is a fantastic opportunity to share our teaching skills with the wider community. It began in September 2021 with a series of musical foundation classes at Reception and will build over 3 years with each individual child learning a stringed instrument.

By 2024, 180 children from Corpus Christi will have been involved in the programme which will also train teachers at the school to deliver it for years to come.
