Summer Term in Year 1





Our Topics: 'Plant Detectives' 'Significant Figures'



Topic

This term in Topic we are looking at significant people throughout history.

In the first half-term we will be learning about authors Julia Donaldson and J.M.Barrie. We will look at what they have written and why they are important. We will then compare their similarities and differences.

After half-term we will be looking at Neil Armstrong to coincide with the 50th anniversary of the moon landings.

English

In the first half-term we will be reading the story 'Jim and the Beanstalk' and creating our own version of the story. After half-term we will look at instructions.

Phonics

The National Phonics Screening Check will take place the week beginning Monday 10th June. We will send home more information regarding the screening check as the date approaches. Children are supported daily within their phonics groups and across the curriculum. You may support your child at home by continuing to read daily.

Maths

We will be consolidating our Maths learning from the year, as well as introducing multiplication and division. We will also be learning to tell the time to half past the hour, using language to describe position and direction and using standard measures relating to length, height, weight and volume.

Science

This term in Science we are learning about plants. The children will each get a chance to plant their own seed. We will also look at the difference between wild and planted flowers. Finally we will consider the changes across seasons and how this affects nature.

We will also link this to our Science work. We will also look at changes in climate across the world and become area of the part we have to play in sustaining our earth.
