All outstanding balances should now be paid. Please return completed medical forms to the school office as soon as possible along with your child's pocket money.

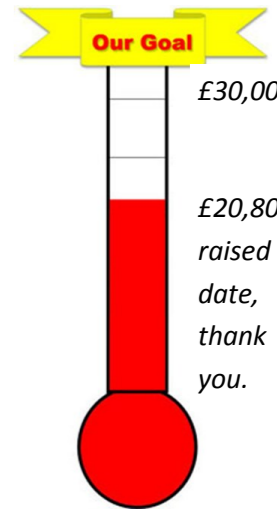

Parents have also raised an additional £20,000 which is in the bank and shall go towards any future purchases for the benefit of the children, including a new minibus. Well done!



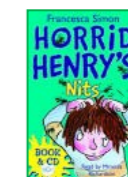
School Photographer
