Security Update

Yesterday, following Monday evening's terrorist attack in Manchester, the school observed the nation's minute silence. The flag has been at half-mast as a reminder to the children to keep the families continually in their prayers. Lambeth are putting in place measures to reflect the heightened threat

level. That means security will be reviewed at all their buildings and at any large or significant events in the borough over the next few days. We are also reviewing security and emergency arrangements on trips. Whilst the threat level is at critical, school trips into London will be cancelled. We will be reviewing this after half term, particularly if the threat level is reduced. Local trips and the Year 2 trip to the seaside will still take place.
