SCENARIO 1

THE FREE ROBUX TRAP

You're playing Roblox when a message pops up from someone you don't know.

They say, 'I can give you 1,000 free Robux if you just click this link!'

It sounds amazing because you've been wanting new outfits for your avatar.

What would you do?

Key Discussion Points:

- **Is it too good to be true?**
- **Why clicking links from strangers is risky.**
- **The importance of telling an adult.**



SCENARIO 2 THE FAKE MR BEAST GIVEAWAY

You're watching YouTube, and suddenly a video pops up that says, 'MrBeast is giving away £1,000! Just enter your details to win!' The website looks real, and there's even a countdown timer to make you hurry.

What would you do?

Key Discussion Points:


- **Scammers pretending to be famous people.**

SCENARIO 3

THE UNBELIEVABLE FRIEND REQUEST

You're on TikTok (or seeing a sibling use it), and you get a friend request from someone with lots of followers and cool videos. They say they're a famous influencer and want to be friends—but they start asking you personal questions like where you live and what school you go to.

What would you do?



Key Discussion Points:


- **Why having lots of followers doesn't mean someone is trustworthy.**
- **Protecting personal information.**
- **Blocking and reporting features.**

SCENARIO 4

THE 'URGENT' MESSAGE FROM A GAME COMPANY

You receive a message that looks like it's from Minecraft saying, 'Your account will be deleted unless you click this link and verify your details right now!' You don't want to lose your progress, so you're tempted to click.

What would you do?



Key Discussion Points:

- **How phishing messages work.**
- **Checking for signs of a scam (spelling mistakes, strange links, pressure to act fast).**
- **What to do if you're unsure—ask an adult before clicking.**
