## How You Can Help at Home

- Talk positively about the move and encourage your child to share how they feel.

- Practise organisational skills, such as preparing their own bag or managing their belongings.
- Revisit routines that will help them adjust more easily, such as bedtime and morning routines.
- Remind them that it's normal to feel unsure—many other children will feel the same.
