To achieve this, teachers use a variety of strategies and approaches, drawing on multisensory and question-based theories. We understand that all classes are unique and respond to different approaches and have varied needs, meaning that our teaching strategies need to be flexible to meet all children's needs. However, all our curriculum learning starts with a key question to promote curiosity and introduce new language. These questions are designed to lead learning so that selected key knowledge can be taught, applied and secured, identified as our 'sticky knowledge'.

Language Rich To provide a language rich curriculum which enables children to apply core skills, broaden their vocabulary and be immersed in high quality texts.	At Coupe Green we believe that language opens up the wider world to our children. It is vital that children are taught key language to enable them to become subject experts. We believe that giving children this knowledge promotes confidence and focusses teaching and learning to ensure that our curriculum is knowledge based.		Key texts, ambitious vocabulary (sticky knowledge) Each half term classes have a new key text which links to lead subjects and establishes a theme to focus experiences and links across the curriculum. All key texts are chosen by school staff and are selected to broaden our children's language, supporting writing targets and excite and enthuse. The key texts enable staff to promote high expectations for writing, vocabulary and subject specific language whilst developing children as experts in lead subjects. Key vocabulary is planned through our subject skill progression maps and medium-term plans and is progressive across school. This vocabulary is displayed in classroom and used to support teacher assessment.
