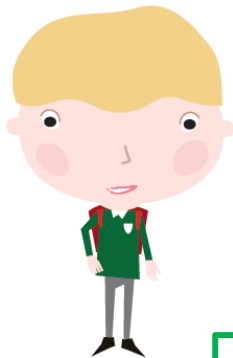

What is it?





What is it for?

To help you decide what could be a problem and where to get help and support. It is really important that you know who you can talk to and also to understand why you might need to talk to someone.



What is a DSL?

DSL stands for Designated Safeguarding Lead. In every school there is always somebody who has the responsibility to keep you safe and all staff have to tell that person if they are worried about you. Staff have training and are taught to keep children safe as it is the most important part of their job.

In our school, the DSLs are Mrs Littlewood, Mr Burns and Mrs Cooke, as well as Mr Mycock, who is our Chair of Governors.

It is everyone job, who works in school, to keep you safe, so remember you can talk to any grown up that you trust.

If you are upset or worried about something that has happened to you or someone else then please remember you can be brave and talk to someone who will listen to you and help you.

If you speak to a grown up, sometimes they will need to check things with your DSL. Grown-ups in school can not keep secrets because their job is to help you and keep you safe, which means they may sometimes need to share your worries with other grownups who can help.
