We monitor children's attendance each half term, so that we can support families quickly, when attendance is at risk of being below target or persistently absent. When monitoring attendance, we consider authorised absences, diagnosed illness / periods of sickness, and absences which have been discussed via request forms. When children's attendance is identified as at risk of being below the school target or categorised as persistent absence, school will inform parents and act quickly to support attendance increasing. We value your support and co-operation in ensuring that all our children access the very best education.
