What a wonderful start Acorn Class have had to our half term. We launched our first outdoor learning day, where we completed lots of super activities. We have learned about Remembrance Day and created some super clay poppies. We have also kick started our new English unit about The Three Little Pigs and cannot wait to build houses outside.

Oak Class have been thoroughly enjoying their new theme 'Life in the toy museum'. The children have been exploring toys from the past and comparing them to toys they play with now, in school and at home. They have even been to Oak Class's Toy Museum! In Geography, we have been continuing our learning about our world and learning about the equator. We loved looking at our own baby photos in RE and thinking about why babies are special and how they are welcomed into the word in different religions. We are looking forward to our class trip to the theatre at the end of this half term!

Elm Class have loved diving into the world of fairytales and really enjoyed reading and watching snippets of the film Cinderella in order to work out the meaning of unfamiliar words, such as sullen, stove and cinders. In Ash Class, we have been enjoying our new topic about Romans. We have loved writing our gladiator diary entries and have enjoyed researching the different types of gladiators. Children have had their first recorder lessons and are excited to be able to play a tune with the different notes learnt later in the half term.

This half term, Maple Class will be learning about the water cycle and animal classification. We are already loving our new class novel – 'The Lone Husky' by Hannah Gold and have received our signed copies! We are super excited about our trip to Lunt Meadows Nature Reserve in a few weeks.
