Strengths of School

The responses received were very positive and it was wonderful to hear that 99% - 100% of families who completed the questionnaire believe:

- School is well led and managed
- School is welcoming
- Children feel safe
- School is helping children to become mature, responsible and independent
- School works in partnership with parents
- Teaching is good
- Families are kept well informed about children's progress

The additional comments recognised the importance and implementation of our school values, *Respect, Kindness, Love & Equality and Honesty*, and how much school staff care about children.

At Coupe Green our main priorities are developing our children as rounded, happy and kind individuals, who feel cared for, recognised and safe. The comments made by families supported our school priorities, recognising the work of the staff team to ensure that children have opportunities which enable them to reach their full potential – thank you!

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Areas to Develop

Comments shared regarding ways in which school could improve was to review our communication platforms, with some suggestions made, that one platform would be more manageable. We did explore this last year and obtained a number of quotes but our existing platforms were still financially the most competitive. School budgets are under increasing pressure and we have to consider Best Value in all we do, so unfortunately, we are unable to change our communication platforms at this time. We will however keep this regularly under review.

After school club opportunities were also highlighted. In response to this, our after-school club offer has been reviewed. School staff now provide two after school clubs each over the school year, totalling 24 opportunities, along with outside agency clubs, provided through South Ribble Sports, Kick On and Church links. We are also exploring the possibility of a gymnastics club provided by an outside agency.

It was also pleasing to hear that our Kids Club is popular, and more places would be desirable. Our provision will be reviewed in light of this and if possible, staffing increases made so that more children could be accommodated.

Friends of Coupe Green

From reading responses to questions regarding Friends of Coupe Green (FOCG), it was clear that families value the work that they do and the experiences that they create for our children. The FOCG team aim to create lasting memories for all children and this is always their main priority. In doing so, they also raise vital funds for school, ensuring that we can continue to provide resources for our children and develop school, particularly school grounds and wider resources. Without them, we simply would have not achieved some of the most impactful developments in school to date.

In order for their great work to continue they need support. At the moment they are running on a very low number of volunteers, which puts them at risk of not being able to continue. If their work stopped, it would be a significant loss to school.

There were a number of responses stating that they would be happy to help at Friends of Coupe Green events. Any help that can be given, no matter how small, would be greatly appreciated.
