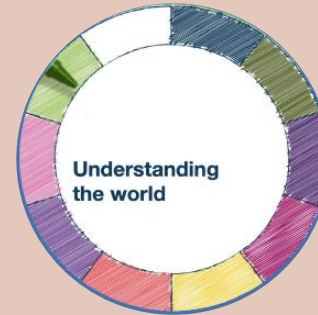
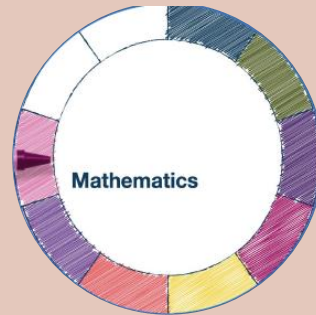
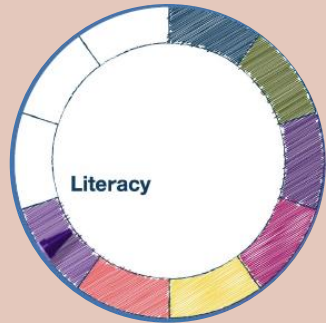
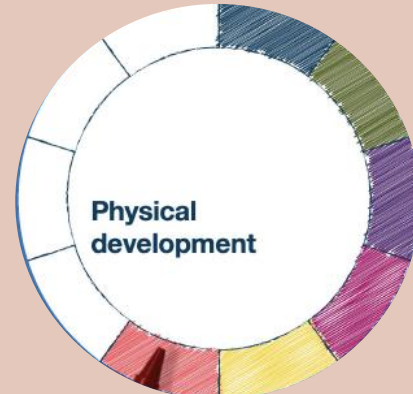
# The Importance of Play
