



Acorn Class – Reception Under the Sea

This half term we will be finishing off our year by learning about Under the Sea! We will use high quality texts as starting points – including Rainbow Fish, The Undersea Cleaning Spree, and Julian's a Mermaid. This will follow the children's interests in the environment and recycling/responsible living.

In Phonics we will continue our journey through phase 4, consolidating our clusters and learning the remainder of the tricky words.

In maths we will continue to consolidate key skills – subitising, counting, composition, sorting and matching, comparing and ordering. We will begin to build and identify numbers to 20 and beyond using a range of resources, sharing, doubling and odd and even numbers.

This last half term will be a really crucial one for Expressive Art and Design, particularly creating with materials. We'll be putting lots of opportunities in for everyone to access the materials and resources and really show us what they can do.
