AO1, AO2, AO3 Main Coursework Unit- The focus is on ensuring everything is up to standard from year 10 before they proceed to developments. Students will: - -Continue to build and develop their major project. -Ensure a range of different developments are produced which reflect their 3 selected artists (minimum 6 developments). -Ensure at least 3 different compositions are created for the Final piece. -Complete a 7th initial drawing to support their developments. -Draw close analysis drawings on the pages around their larger initial drawings. -Ensure all pages are annotated with good written comments. -Ensure all ideas pages are completed and relate to the chosen theme.
