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




EMPLOYER ENGAGEMENT

Crewe UTC students spent 2 hours at The Peacock Railway inspecting the track and taking measurements. This hands-on experience is all part of an exciting Employer Set Project, where our students are actively working on solutions to improve railway operations through coming up with a Traverser solution.

At the Peacock miniature railway in Nantwich the replacement of failed locomotives from the front of the queue in their busy little station area has been a growing challenge on busy days when they have their track open to the public during the Spring and Summer period. It's crucial for the team to swiftly move a failed loco away from the working line and replace it with a functioning loco to keep operations running smoothly and customers happy!
