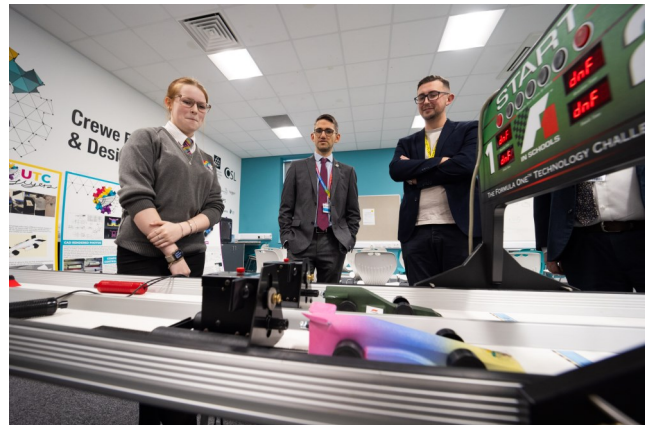
MP VISIT - Mr Connor Naismith
