Yr 10 Exam Information

As we are approaching the end of the year, your child's teachers will soon be assessing the progress they have made over the year. This information will be included in the end of year report which will be shared with you in July.

Ongoing assessment is a feature of all learning at Crewe UTC and at this key time, all students will be sitting end of year assessments in most subjects. The timetable for these assessments is accompanies this letter and can also be found on the Exams Information tab on our website HERE. The assessments will be conducted in the same manner as GCSE examinations which require students to follow Exam Board guidelines. On the Crewe UTC website, you will find documents which highlight these guidelines and I encourage you and your child to read them carefully, so they are aware of them.

Exam Access Arrangements (EAA)

Exam Access Arrangements allow some students with special educational needs, disabilities or temporary injuries to access the assessment without changing the demands of the assessment. We have already identified some students who may qualify for these access arrangements and will be trialling them during these assessments, for example extra time allowance, use of a word processor etc, where these are part of a student's normal way of working in class. More formal assessments of EAA will take place in the Autumn term.
