- Mr Kelleher welcomed the children, asked them about their Christmas break and recapped the last meeting to refresh their memories.
- Mr Kelleher thanked the children again for their efforts with our hall display and complimented how good the display looked.
- Mr Kelleher went on to remind the children of our new project for this term, to create leaflets detailing what living with autism is like. [Idea suggested previously by AH (Legends 1)]
- The children then spent some time looking at examples of previously existing leaflets about Autism, discussing what the liked about them and talking about some of the facts they found. BH (Avengers) pointed out that some of the things listed as ASD challenges were things that he didn't find challenging. Mr Yates commented that Autism is a spectrum condition, and everyone experiences it differently. Even though we all have the same condition, our experiences with Autism are very unique. The children agreed with this.
- Mr Kelleher asked the children to vote on which of the previously existing leaflets they liked best, which we could use to base our own off. The children voted and decided to use a mixture of two examples. JQ (All Stars 1) commented on how he liked the colours on one of the leaflets and BLG (Legends 2) said he really liked the use of the pictures on the other.

In our next session, the A team will begin to create our leaflets. Mr Kelleher will be emailing to inform teachers that this will be a longer meeting. Our next meeting will take place 1st February.
