In September we welcomed our new class of All Stars!

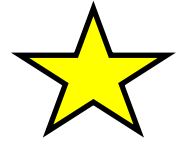

Maths



This term we have been learning all about

- Number and Place value
- Length and Mass/weight
- Addition and Subtraction
- 2-D and 3-D shape



English



This term we have been learning all about

- Stories with Familiar Settings
- Non-Chronological Reports
- Poems on a Theme





All Stars afternoons consist of lots of learning which we try to make exciting and fun

Spanish

We will be learning numbers 1 to 10 in Spanish and the names of the colours of the rainbow.



Computing

We will be learning about internet safety and computer programming.



Music

We will be finding out about composing, singing, clapping rhythms, finding the pulse and playing instruments. At the end of the unit the class will perform to their peers.



PSHRE

We will be focussing on 'Being Me in my world.' This will include work centred around feeling special and safe, being part of a class, rights and responsibilities, rewards and feeling proud.





Science

We will be learning about materials and their uses and key vocabulary related to the topic. We will also be learning about significant scientists such as John Loudon McAdam and Julie Brusaw.



Geography

This half term our topic is 'Home sweet home.' We will be learning where we live and why it is special. To understand the area, we live in is within the UK. Children will also be learning the difference between a small scale and large-scale map.



PE

Dance around the world: - Children will be able to share what they know about the theme, creatively use the words from the mind map to help us move in different ways and show good timing, posture and extension.



RE

We will learn why the Bible is a special book and understand that other faiths have different holy books that have some similarities and differences between them.

Art & Design

We will understand what an observational drawing is and how colour can be used in an observational art piece. We will then work with clay to make animals from our topic. The children will learn to sculpt, mould, roll and squeeze the clay
