

English

This term we will be focussing on stories by the same author, which will be Lauren Child. The children will explore a range of Charlie and Lola stories and explore the characters and themes within these. We will then explore non-chronological reports about animals around the world before writing our own. To finish off the half term, we will be focusing on poetry about the seaside.

Mathematics

This term we will be focussing on number and place value up to 10. We will use a range of practical equipment to represent these numbers and explore the value of the numbers. We will then move on to adding and subtracting number within 10 in a range of practical ways.

Science

This half term we will be exploring the human body; we will identify, name, draw and label parts of the human body and identify the associated parts linked to the five senses. We will then move on to look at a range of seasonal changes.

Fundamental movement skills
Children will focus on:

- That good balance means stillness
- Which parts of the body help with balancing
- Using 2 feet to land jumps
- Being balanced helps with throwing and catching

Humanities – Geography

Our World_- Hot & Cold Countries.
Children will learn what the continents and the oceans of the world are, which are hot and cold countries, what animals live in these different countries and the differences between them.

Other Curriculum Areas

Computing - Text and images

Children will learn how to save and open work, how to create a picture on the computer and how to change the style of text.

RE - Christianity

The children will explore the key question 'What do Christians believe about God?'
Children will focus on the Christian story of Creation from the Old Testament and the responsibility a Christian might feel for caring for the world. We will also explore the commandment to 'Love your neighbour as yourself' from the New Testament to understand how a Christian might feel about caring for other people.

Music - My Musical heartbeat

Children will learn that every piece of music has a heartbeat - a musical heartbeat. In music, we call it the 'pulse' or the 'beat' of the music.

Art & Design - Clay animals

Children will learn what an observational drawing is, how colour should be used in an observational art piece and how clay is used to make models.
