






All Stars 2 Autumn Governors Report 2022

We started off as 5 but were lucky enough to get some new faces who joined us later on!






Maths




In Maths this term, we began by learning about height, weight, length and mass. The children were able to work practically, measuring each other's heights and weighing various items in the classroom. We since moved on and have learnt about tens and units, inverse equations and solving various addition/subtraction equations using rod and dots and the leap frog method. We have also looked at representing the hundreds, tens and units with British currency to see the understanding our pupils have of money. The All Stars have just begun to look at both adding and subtracting using inverse operation and through the use of base 10. We are finishing off the term looking at 2D and 3D shapes





English

In English this term, we have been looking at a variety of fiction and non-fiction books. We have also been looking at different authors and began the term looking at the author Julia Donaldson. We looked at a number of books such as 'The Smartest Giant in town', 'Room on the Broom' and 'The Gruffalo's child'. This term we have also been looking at the features of non-chronological reports, such as titles, subheadings and illustrations. We have recently begun to create our own news reports on our school forest and we have also looked at letters which we then wrote to our late Queen Elizabeth II. We are finishing the term learning about poems on a theme.





Thrive



In Thrive this term, the All Stars have worked really hard and have enjoyed a variety of fun filled lessons! The children have been looking at emotions and feelings. For one of our sessions the children were asked to think of a safe space that is special to them, which they can go to in order to relax and do something that they enjoy to do i.e. read a book. The children also enjoyed a Thrive session where they were asked to create their own piece of music on the app 'Garage Band'. The children enjoyed exploring the app and making lots of different music pieces. We also took part in a session with soft puppets where the children were able to communicate different thoughts, feelings and emotions through the use of the puppets.

Forest School

In Forest School this term, we have lots of fun and have taken part in lots of different activities. We have had Miss Clough as our forest leader and she has taught us so many different skills. We have learnt the safety rules of using a fire, we have learnt different balancing skills and we have also learnt about the importance of working as a team in the forest. We have been lucky enough to roast marshmallows on an open fire which was great fun. We have had fun on the balancing beams, hammock and have even been searching for bugs! We made our very own feeders for all of the birds in the forest and have enjoyed playing lots of games such as hide and seek and duck duck goose.
