Titans

Humanities - History

This half term our topic is 'Fire Fire!' We will look into what happened during the great fire of London and explore fire safety and using equipment from the past that would be used against blazes and compare them to what firefighters use today.

Other Curriculum Areas

Computing

Digital Research - We will explore how to find information out on a computer and also how to maintain safety when researching or accessing online tools.

Gifts and Giving - This unit will deliver learning around the importance of Christmas to Christians and other religions that celebrate around this time of year. We will focus on giving and why charity is helpful and kind.

Art & Design

Clay Animals/ Art from the past - We will understand what an observational drawing is and how colour can be used in an observational art piece. We will then work with clay to make animals from our topic. The children will learn to sculpt, mould, roll and squeeze the clay.
