

English

Our English this half term will focus around stories by the same author.

The children will study a range of texts and explore patterns and themes within the stories. They will begin to share their likes/dislikes around the themes and express their views with others. We will also explore non-chronological reports and how these are used as information texts. Finally, we will explore a range of poems around a theme that the children have shown interest in.

Mathematics

Throughout this half term, we will be focusing on place value and understanding number. We will be recognising the value of each digit in a number, comparing numbers using < and > and using a range of resources to represent numbers. We will also be focusing on addition and subtraction and applying this in a range of practical ways.

Science

The Human Body - We will be learning all about our bodies. We will learn the names of the different parts and their function. We will also be learning about our senses and explore different things using these senses.

PSHRE

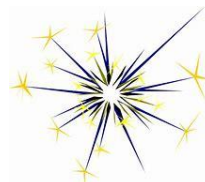
We will be focussing on 'Being Me In My World.' Our learning will be centred around feelings of being safe and feeling special, our rights and responsibilities and working

Humanities

This half term our topic is 'Our World.' We will be naming continents and oceans. We will be identifying hot and cold countries, the weathers associated with hot and cold and naming animals that come from these countries.

Other Curriculum Areas

These subjects will centre around and embed learning within our 'Our World' topic.

Computing

Text & Images – We will know how to save and open work, create a picture on the computer and change the style of text.

RE

Christianity – We will be exploring the religion Christianity. We will explore what Christians believe about God and we will look at stories about God.

Art & Design

Clay Animals – We will understand what an observational drawing is and how colour can be used in an observational art piece. We will then work with clay to make animals from our topic. The children will learn to sculpt, mould, roll and squeeze the clay.

Introducing Beat – The children will find the pulse, march in time with the pulse, be an animal that finds the pulse, clap rhythms and copy them back.
