

## English

Our English this half term will focus around Poetry. We will be exploring a range of poems and grouping them into limericks, shape poems and acrostic poems. Children will be able to identify rhyming patterns within the poems. Towards the end of the unit the children will be writing their own riddle based on ones we have read.

## Mathematics

Over this half term we will be focussing on three main areas; Money, Multiplication and Division and Length and Height.

Children will be taught various mental and written methods to draw upon and will be provided with a range of practical apparatus to use when required.

## Science

This unit will focus on Forces and Magnets. The children will learn about forces, friction and magnetic attraction. They will learn about forces in the context of pushing and pulling, and will identify different actions as pushes or pulls. The children will work scientifically and collaboratively to investigate friction.

## Outdoor Learning inc. Forest School & Visits

Our forest theme will link to our Science topic on Forces. The children will explore how trees remain standing, why do leaves fall to the ground, the effect of wind, the impact of erosion and deposition. Children will be completing a range of activities within the school grounds experimenting the above questions to find out their own answers. Children will be working closely in partners and small teams.

## PSHRE

Within this unit we will be focussing on 'Dreams and Goals.' This will include work centred around children setting their own achievable goals and discussing their aspirations. Children will learn how to feel proud of their achievements.

## PE & Physical Activity

Throughout this unit we will be focussing Health related fitness, children will begin to learn what the following skills are and how they can develop them; stamina, flexibility and core strength.
