Incredibles- animal books, the runaway pea, gangsta granny strikes again, books that celebrate differences/diversity.
All Stars 2- HA said they want funny books and forest themed books. Miss Clough said there is a good book called 'poodunit' and it's to identify animal poop. All children wanted this. Miss Sharp said she has this book and likes it.
HA said he has entered a 'pride' themed colouring competition and is hoping for a 'win, win, because I tried so hard.' Mr Pilling said he was impressed.
