

Fireworks




Spring 2022

English

This half term we began by looking at newspaper reports and features that are included. For inspiration, we looked at different kinds of 'Incredible sports' such as Bossaball. The Fireworks children created some fantastic newspaper reports of their own about an 'Incredible sport' of their choice. We have also been looking at fantasy fiction, particularly 'The Spiderwick Chronicles.' The children have thoroughly enjoyed reading this book whilst developing their understanding of inference.



Maths

In maths, our children have been working really hard and have been expanding their knowledge of mental addition, fractions, positional language for coordinates, area and measurement. Fireworks have shown great enthusiasm and understanding in their maths this term and are developing the skill to independently use different methods to solve problems.



Science

For our science this term we have been looking at solids, liquids and gases. Fireworks class have been learning how to identify what makes a solid, liquid and a gas and each of their particle arrangement. As an experiment we made 'Oobleck.' Oobleck is a substance that can mimic the qualities of a solid and a liquid. We had so much fun making it!



Forest

This term we had the pleasure of having Mr Henderson for a few sessions. In these sessions we were able to learn how to safely light a fire and if we behaved safely and sensibly we were rewarded with marshmallows and we could toast them on the fire. We have also been working on our teamwork skills.
