The Incredibles have had a great year. We have learnt lots of new things and have all developed academically as well as personally, socially and emotionally.



English

In the Incredibles class, we have listened to the book 'Library Lion' and discussed and wrote different rules for in a Library. We have been looking at nonsense poems by Edward Lear and created our own nonsense poems. We have also been looking at the days of the week and features of a diary. We read the story 'Waiting for Goliath' and wrote a diary from Goliath's point of view.



Maths

In Maths we have been exploring measure, fractions, time, tally charts and tables. We have been looking at measuring in centimetres and metres. Whilst exploring fractions, we looked at halves, quarters and found wholes. Linked to our fractions work, we have been looking at time and recognising quarter to and quarter past. We have also explored how many minutes there are in an hour. We have also been looking at tally charts and seeing if we can create our own tally charts and tables. Our Maths lessons are very practical and the children enjoy learning through play.



Science

This term in Science we have been looking at different habitats and what animals and plants live in different habitats. We have learnt about food chains and what animals/plants are at the top of the food chain or the bottom of the food chain. We have also been exploring what things that are living, dead or never alive.



Foundation Subjects

In Geography we have been learning about Kenya. We have looked at what different animals that you would see on a Kenyan safari and different activities that the children do in Kenya. In History we have been learning about the Industrial Revolution and the cotton mills in Lancashire. We looked at different machines that are being used within cotton mills and what it would be like for children living in the Victorian era. In PSHRE we have been looking at things we can do to help keep our bodies healthy by looking at the calories, fat and sugar that we could be putting into our bodies. We have also been looking at different people's roles and responsibilities and if males and females have the same roles and responsibilities.



Outdoor Learning

This term we have enjoyed a lot of our learning in the outdoor environment. We have made Kenyan houses, looked at different micro habitats that we have found in the forest and made a loom with two trees and string.
